Cedar Housing opened its first support service for young women aged 16-25, experiencing or threatened by homelessness. We are now looking for a **Project Team Leader** to manage an existing team of three Support Workers and three Night Support Workers.

You will oversee the day to day running of the service, including referrals and move-ons, facilitating on- and off-site education, training and activities, managing resources, and representing the charity to external agencies.

You will have relevant experience of working with disaffected young women, relevant qualification(s) to NVQ 3 or equivalent, and two years previous experience of managing people. We will give you the opportunity to work with committed staff and volunteers and the reward of seeing vulnerable young women fulfilling their potential. Salary: £21,237 - £26,750 per annum based on a 37.5 hour week.
